## **Race Courses:**

**5k course** is on paved roadways through a neighborhood adjacent to Timbrook Park. It features a mix of hills and flats.

**1 mile mutt strut** is a slightly rolling walk along paths in the grass and through the woods at Timbrook Park. Lots of interesting scenery for people and dogs along the way! This is a leisurely walk that is not timed.

#### Other information:

Post race food and water will be available for runners and walkers. Water will be available for dogs.
