Race Courses:

5k course is on paved roadways through a
neighborhood adjacent to Timbrook Park. It fea-
tures a mix of hills and flats.

1 mile mutt strut is a slightly rolling walk along
paths in the grass and through the woods at Tim-
brook Park. Lots of interesting scenery for people
and dogs along the way! This is a leisurely walk
that is not timed.

Other information:

Post race food and water will be available for run-
ners and walkers. Water will be available for dogs.

There will be door prizes for participants.

Fine Print: All dogs attending must be up to date
on vaccinations, and remain on a leash at all times.
Participation is at your own risk and waiver must
be signed to participate in the 5k or 1 mile.
